SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Purpose: To provide a one-time college scholarship to students in each region attending Morehouse College. If there is not a max of three (3) qualified candidates per region, a region may have more than one winner.

Award: Scholarships will be awarded to students by the Scholarship Committee of the Morehouse College Parents Council (MCPC). Scholarships will be awarded in the name of the Student and College for academic purposes only. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the MCPC Scholarship Committee and announced on the MCPC website in April of 2025.

Eligibility: Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet all the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be a **full-time** student at **Morehouse College with a cumulative 2.0 GPA.**
2. Applicant must submit a copy of their most recent transcript.
3. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials by the deadline (**Friday, February 28, 2025, no later than 11:59 pm**)
4. Applications must be submitted to **Morehouseparentcouncil@gmail.com.**

The Application and Attachments: Please provide detailed answers to the application questions and submit all required attachments. Applications that are not completed will not be considered. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence.

Required materials for a complete application:

1. A completed application form
2. An unofficial copy of the most recent transcript
3. Three letters of Recommendation from internships, church leaders, employers, coaches from the past three years 2022-2025
4. A professional headshot must include a well-lit, frontal facing photo exposing torso and face
5. An essay 750 words (or less) addressing the following topic:

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Essays and recommendation letters must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent, readable font, with numbered pages and one-inch margins.
